Chicken Use Regulations

Keeping of Female Chickens

- (1) Purpose and Intent. It is the desire of the Town Board to permit residents in single family residential zoning districts to keep a small number of female chickens on their property, on a non-commercial basis, as a permissible accessory use while also protecting neighbors and the community from noise, odors, and other negative aspects of raising chickens.
- (2) The keeping of female chickens is permitted in all single-family residential districts.
- (3) A maximum of 6 adult female chickens is permitted.
- (4) Roosters or female chickens that crow are not permitted.
- (5) All female chickens must be provided adequate shelter with appropriate ventilation.
- (6) If female chickens are allowed to roam outside of the shelter, they must be in a confined yard.
- (7) All feed must be stored in sealed containers to prevent attracting vermin.
- (8) No other fowl will be permitted.
- (9) All waste will be removed in an appropriate and timely manner.

Any problems will be taken care of by the Town Board.
