

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
ORDINANCE 91-2

WHEREAS, the Board of Jefferson Township, Green County, Wisconsin, is responsible for public safety in the village of Juda, and

WHEREAS, vehicles parked along the streets of the village of Juda after 48 hours are a public nuisance and a safety hazard, and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of September 1991 the Board of the Township of Jefferson, County of Green, Wisconsin passed a motion to have vehicles parked on the streets in the village of Juda for longer than 48 hours removed, and

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Town Board for the Township of Jefferson, County of Green, Wisconsin, that vehicles must be off the streets of Juda after 48 hours or the vehicles will be towed away at the owners expense.
