JUNE 2024 TOWN BOARD MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Jefferson was **called to order** at 6:00 p.m. on June 14, 2023, at the Juda Community Center. In attendance were Doug Mayer, Kurt Jordan, Rick Nusbaum, Amy McCullough, Joe Jones, Gary Preston, Jeff and Teri Mahlkuch, and Nick Hartwig.

Doug **verified notices had been posted** at the Juda Post Office, the Juda Community Center, and at the Recycling Garage. A notice was also published on the Town of Jefferson's website.

For **public input**, Nick Hartwig attended the meeting to give some information about the future plans for the old lumberyard property on Lumberyard Rd.

Liquor licenses were reviewed, with Rick making a motion to approve. Kurt seconded and the motion carried.

The **Clerk's report** was reviewed with Rick making a motion to approve. Kurt seconded and the motion carried. Board of Review minutes were also reviewed. Rick made a motion to approve, and Kurt seconded. Motion carried.

The **Treasurer's report** was reviewed, noting cash on hand as of May 31 at \$202,921.64. Doug made a motion and Rick seconded to accept the report. Motion carried.

There was nothing to report for the **planning commission**.

For **road maintenance**, Joe is working on shouldering and patching. The board briefly discussed possibly abandoning the far east end of Montgomery Road. The topic will be further discussed at the July meeting. Rustin Whitney received a driveway permit.

The **bills** were circulated through board members. Kurt made a motion and Rick seconded to **approve payment of bills**. Motion carried.
