

TOWN OF JEFFERSON

DECEMBER 2024 TOWN BOARD MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Jefferson was **called to order** at 6:00 p.m. on December 11, 2024, at the Juda Community Center. In attendance were Doug Mayer, Kurt Jordan, Rick Nusbaum, Amy McCullough, Joe Jones, and Will Burchard.

Doug **verified notices had been posted** at the Juda Post Office, the Juda Community Center, and at the Recycling Garage. A notice was also published on the Town of Jefferson's website.

For **public input**,

- Lyle Samson has some trees along the side of the road that he would like removed. Joe will cut the trees down and Lyle will take care of all the cleanup.
- Rick requested that the township put "no through truck traffic" signs up on both ends of Franklin Street to prevent large trucks from using it. The street is too narrow for large truck traffic.

Doug made a motion to approve a **Treasurer's Bond Ordinance** for the Town of Jefferson. Rick seconded and the motion carried.

The **Clerk's report** was reviewed with Doug making a motion to approve. Kurt seconded and the motion carried. In other correspondence:

- The annual meeting of the Juda and Community Fire Association is January 13, 2025.
- An amended contract from Green County Solid Waste was discussed and signed.

The **Treasurer's report** was reviewed, noting cash on hand as of November 30, 2024, at \$173,185.68. Rick made a motion and Kurt seconded to accept the report. Motion carried.

There was nothing to report for the **planning commission**.

For **road maintenance**, Joe has been trimming trees and preparing the plows for snow. There were no driveway permits to report.

The **bills** were circulated through board members. Kurt made a motion and Rick seconded to **approve payment of bills**. Motion carried.

The **next meeting** will be on Wednesday, January 8, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

The **meeting was adjourned** on a motion by Rick and a second by Kurt. Motion carried.
